Mr. Jackson updated the Committee on the process to date and reviewed proposed Official Plan Amendment No. 7 and the accompanying implementing zoning by-law amendment. Mr. Jackson described in general terms the underlying philosophy of maintaining the status quo and a more environmentally friendly, restrictive approach to the proposed policies. Mr. Jackson then went through the proposed amendment clause by clause making note of the Committee's questions and comments. Mr. Michalski reviewed with the Committee the Recreational Boating Study and the data collected. Mr. Michalski spoke to the narrow channel problem areas and stated that he would be recommending that speed restrictions be put in place in these locations. Mr. Michalski stated that he would provide the data collected for posting on the Township web site. Mr. Jackson requested the Committee's direction and comments regarding the proposed amendments.

Reeve Moore opened the floor up to questions, comments and concerns regarding the proposed Official Plan Amendment and proposed Zoning By-law Amendment.
